"Everything is needed at Kids in Distress," says former "kindy-garten" teacher Cindi Elias, "from loving care to money." Their 2 biggest needs are kids' sneakers and portacrib sheets. They don't want worn-out things - and don't accept things you wouldn't give to your own kids or grandchildren. They do appreciate the "blankies and pillows" that BCREA members have donated for several years and they are always in need of school supplies. A \$25 donation



buys a school uniform! Thev have helped 6 -7,000 kids in the past year in one way

or another. They deal with such problems as kids who have arrived with cigarette burns on their bodies; kids who save part of their breakfast because they aren't sure if they will get any more food; 4-year-olds who arrive not

knowing their numbers or colors: and one of the worst cases was that of a 10-year-old who gave birth. She didn't even know she was pregnant! There are success stories too! One of their former kids is now a Harvard graduate! On the **KID** campus in Wilton Manor there is now a dental clinic and an optometry clinic that accept Medicaid. And they have a pre-school that is open to the public hence their name change to the acronym "KID." To learn all about KID, go to http://www.kidinc.org.

ship Raffle were Carol Roland(\$20),


