George Gadson: Polk County to the White House!

Sculptor George Gadson hails from Polk County, FL, graduated from Duke, studied in Valencia, Spain and became a banker - and then found his passion. He enrolled in Hillsborough Community College to study art in 1981 and the rest is history - it became his life. At the December meeting, he shared his most important works in a slide show. His work



includes paintings, photography and even poetry (Art Psalms, 2007) as well as sculpture and vary in size from the tiny Christmas ornament to the 12-foot sculpture at the African-American Cultural Center. He chairs the Public Art Committee in Tamarac and served as the lead designer in Dania Beach's Art & Antiques Design Report. In December of 2008, he designed an ornament for the White House Christmas Tree. Being able to take his mother to the White House when the ornament was presented was an emo-

tional time for both of them sioned Gadson to design - and especially to be there with the first black President. In 1995 and 1999, the South Florida Super Bowl Host Committee commis-



commemorative bronze sculptures that were given as gifts to the National Football League teams' owners and Super Bowl VIP's. If and when the Super Bowl is held here again, he will do another one.
