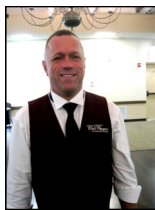


Villagers, Under New Leadership, Still Special!

wrapped boxes that represented the different colleges and universities that scholarship money was

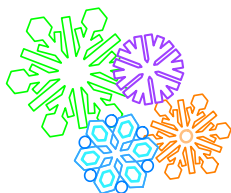


sent to for our scholarship recipients.

Next month we will address our connections with the legislature and the laws that they will be considering in 2016. It is important that we know what is being planned for the future.



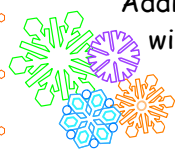
Echo

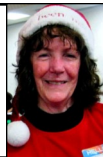

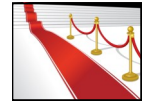

Welcome to the New Year! This is the time we make all those wonderful promises to do all of the ideal things to improve our health and our lives. Very important to having a good life is to have a good mind that will promote a sense of well-being and happiness. Experts agree that one of the most important factors in achieving a sense of well being is to have friends..

Harvard researchers found that friends can help you lose weight if you need to. People who join a weight loss program with a friend are more likely to complete the program than those who try to go it alone. Australian researchers found that people who had many friends tended to live longer than those with fewer friends. Nurses Health Study found that women who were diagnosed with breast cancer fared better when they had more

friends to lean on.

According to the American Journal of Public Health, elderly women who had a wide network of friends had better cognitive function than those who did not. However, to the contrast, another study found that having many groups of friends on Facebook can be stressful when users try to alter their images with different groups.

If you don't have a circle of friends, make an effort this year to cultivate one. It is
