Not only is Maureen Dinnen Co-chairman of the School Board of Broward County, she's also a member of BCREA. On Thursday, February 7, Maureen addressed the 90 members and friends who attended the BCREA Annual Scholarship Luncheon on at Tropical Acres Restaurant. Essentially, she delivered a "State of the Schools" speech. There was good news and bad news. The good news: Of the 9 School Board members. 6 are former teachers; the School Board is the largest employer in the county; there are now 32

high schools in Broward including Sea Gull - an extensive, well-equipped school for pregnant girls which

keeps them from falling through the cracks; the Sun- FCAT determines funding as set Learning Center for students with emotional problems; and now there is also a Center for Autistic Students. There are numerous magnet programs including the new environmental program at South Plantation HS and the law program with a mock courtroom at Ft. Lauderdale HS. Perhaps the best news is that Broward is the largest fully-accredited school district in the entire United States! The bad news is that schools are underfunded. The state sets the educational budget and the

county has no control over it. well as bonuses; however, they are working to change this. And there seems to be hope that this may happen -Governor Crist seems to listen to suggestions. Maureen sees hard work and dedication today as in the past in school personnel. Florida does believe in public education and this gives her encouragement. And, by the way, she's running for reelection
